This paper concerns a conjecture of the P. Erdős and A. Hajnal [Discrete Appl. Math. 25, No. 1/2, 37-52 (1989; Zbl 715.05052)] that for each graph H there exists a positive constant  $\varepsilon = \varepsilon(H)$  with the property that every graph G on n vertices that does not contain an induced H has a homogeneous set of at least n vertices. It is known that  $\varepsilon = 1/3$  works for H being the 4-cycle or  $K_4 - e$ . In this paper it is proved that if G contains no induced  $C_4$  and  $K_4 - e$ , and  $n \geq 6$ , then G contains a homogeneous set of at least  $\lceil \sqrt{n} \rceil$  vertices.
